## HOW TO FIND THE WORKSHOP SITE

From Richmond – Take I-64 East to Exit 234 (US Rt 199 – Lightfoot). Follow US 199 East approximately 4 miles to the Longhill Road exit (SR 612). Take left turn at traffic light at end of exit ramp onto Longhill Road. Proceed approximately one-half mile (east) on Longhill Road. The Community Center is located on the left, next to Skateboard Park and elevated water storage tank.

From Norfolk – Take I-64 West to Exit 242 (US Rt 199 – Jamestown/Williamsburg). Follow US 199 west for approximately 10 miles to the Longhill Road exit (SR 612). Take right turn at traffic light at end of exit ramp onto Longhill Road. Proceed approximately one-quarter mile (east) on Longhill Road. The Community Center is located on the left, next to Skateboard Park and elevated water storage tank.

Parking – Ample free parking is available at the Community Center.
